Basic book citation format The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

One way to cite a textbook in APA format is to introduce the author in the sentence. Use the last name only. If there are no authors, but there is an editor, the editor should be listed instead. End with the publication year in parentheses.

Add as much as the original publication information as possible. After citing the original publication information, add the electronic publication information. This includes the title of the internet site, the date of electronic publication (if given), and the sponsoring institution or organization. Also, be sure to include the URL.

Date updated: June 19, 2020 An MLA book citation always includes the author (s), title (italicized), publisher, and publication year in the list of Works Cited. If relevant, include the names of any editors or translators, the edition, and the volume. The in-text citation gives the author's last name and a page number in parentheses.

APA Referencing Basics: In-Text Citation In-text references must be included following the use of a quote or paraphrase taken from another piece of work. In-text citations are citations within the main body of the text and refer to a direct quote or paraphrase. They correspond to a reference in the main reference list.

### **How to Cite Sources in APA Citation Format - Mendeley**

An APA in-text citation includes only three items: the last name (s) of the author (s), the year the source was published, and sometimes the page or location of the information. References include more information such as the name of the author (s), the year the source was published, the full title of the source, and the URL or page range.
